

Time	Activity	Description
7:00-8:15	AM EDC Time Inside	Students will start inside with indoor play and read aloud until school starts.
8:15-8:35	Arrival & Morning Routine	Students do the morning routine as they arrive. The routine is to put belongings away, say bye to his/her family, sign in, and do table activity.
	Table Time	Students pick a table and do the activity on the table. Students are learning various literacy, math, science, art, and/or fine motor concepts/skills. The activities are often connected to our theme!
8:35-9:00	Calendar & Circle Time	We review the calendar and schedule and talk about our day. There is tons of math embedded into calendar time.
9:00-9:20	Bible	Bible time is filled with learning stories of the Bible, prayer time, and learning about our faith and being disciples of Jesus.
	Music and Movement	Music time is filled with songs, rhymes, instruments, and use of gross motor equipment. Through music we build and learn various language skills, phonemic awareness, math concepts, music, social skills, and gross motor skills.
9:20-10:00	Self Care & Snack/recess	Snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts and skills. All students will wash their hands before snack and use the restroom if needed. Then students will play on the play yard where various gross motor activities are set up around the playground to practice and develop various gross motor skills. Students can also play on the equipment and in the sandbox daily.
10:00-10:20	Circle Time 1 (Read Aloud/ Literacy)	We begin with reading a book related to our theme. Students share, join in, make meaning, and make connections to build reading comprehension, book knowledge, and/or phonemic awareness. We may also do connecting activities (charts, graphs, songs, ect) to build oral language, social skills, science/math concepts, and various literacy skills.
10:20-10:40	Centers	Our centers are art, blocks, library, pretend, and discovery. New themed activities are added to each center every week. Skills and concepts students are learning during centers are literacy, math, science, art, fine motor, and social skills.
	Art/ Small Group	At some point during center time, students will work with the teacher in a smaller group to learn various literacy, math, or science skills and concepts. New games and activities are introduced at this time to ensure student success. The groups are always changing based on students' ability, interest, and random selection.
10:40-11:10	Math/ Specials	On Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays students will be pulled to work on specific math skills in small groups with the teacher. P On Tuesdays from 10:45-11:15, Music Time with Mrs. Gaston. P On Thursday from 10:45-11:10 Chapel with Pastor Eric or DCE Mrs. Michelle Pavasars P On Wednesdays, from 12:15-12:45pm, Webby Dance Co. for students enrolled in their class.
11:10-11:45	HWT	Students depending on age group will be participating in the Handwriting Without Tears curriculum. This consists of introduction to letters and numbers in a variety of ways.
	Science/ Social Studies	Each week students will be learning about a new Science and Social studies topic following along with our themes.
11:45-12:20	Self Care/ Recess/Lunch	Starting at 12pm students will sit down to eat Lunch while non lunch/nap students leave for the day.
12:20-2:30	Nap Time	Students who are staying for a nap will be put down for nap time. If a student does not nap or wakes up early they are able to play quietly.
2:30-3:00	Self Care/ Recess	Self care needs and recess outside if weather allows.
3:00-6:00	PM EDC Time	Activities: Snack Time, Inside Activities/Crafts, Recess, Storytime.
